6.0	Guest Speaker – Cathy Berkeley Balfour Beatty Locality Steward	
	Cathy opened by thanking the parish council for inviting her to her first meeting with them. She outlined what Balfour Beatty do and how the parish council can help. By working closely with parish councils defects get resolved more quickly and cost effectively. She described how she checks all roads throughout the parish regularly, the A & B roads more frequently than the minor roads, and arranges for pothole repair etc. She outlined that any problems and concerns can always be reported on Herefordshire Councils website via the "Report it" section. She then answered questions about drainage and ditch clearing and the landowners' riparian responsibility to maintain roadside ditches, Herefordshire Council are responsible for cutting grips and maintaining highway drainage metalwork and culverts unless it is a private entrance or driveway. Cathy also answered questions on Public Rights Of Way, footpaths and stiles. It was advised that the parish council appoint a footpath officer that Cathy can liaise with. Once appointed Cathy asked to be informed of their contact details to arrange training.	ALL / CLERK
